The NFDB sponsored one day brainstorming workshop on "Refinement of Marine

Fisheries Management in West Bengal" was conducted at ICAR-CIFE, Kolkata on 6th December 2019. Dr. S. Kishore, IAS, Addl. Chief Secretary of Fisheries, West Bengal chaired the workshop. Shri. R. K. Sinha, IAS, Fisheries Secretary of West Bengal, Mr. Parvez Ahmed Khan, Secretary, SEAI West Bengal, Dr. Joice V. Thomas, CE, NETFISH were presided over the dais. Around 68



participants including Special Secretary, Dept. of Fisheries, Govt. of West Bengal, Scientist in charge of CIFE, Scientists from CIFE, Professor & HOD of Fisheries Engineering, WBUAFS, Kolkata, Chairman of DFFTA & President West Bengal United Fisherman Association, Secretary of DFFTA, Secretary of WEUFA, representatives of other fishermen associations, officers of MPEDA & State Fisheries, NGOs, and HDCs were actively participated in the workshop. Dr. N. A. Talwar. Prof. & HOD, Fisheries Engineering, WBUAFS did a presentation on National Marine Fisheries Bill 2019. Dr. Saptarsh Biswas, Dy. Director of Fisheries, Govt. of West Bengal presented on the present status of Marine Fishing Regulation in West Bengal. Dr. Joice V. Thomas,



through his presentation explained Kerala Marine Fishing Regulation Act. He highlighted that MLS for 58 marine species has been identified by CMFRI which are included in the KMFRA to sustain the resources. All the stakeholders expressed their views towards amendment of MFRA in West Bengal.

NFDB sponsored On-board programme for popularization of square mesh cod end was

conducted at Bahabalapur on 17th December 2019. The programme started with an awareness class for the 15 trainees and then they were taken to the fishing ground for onboard trials using square mesh cod ends. A discussion conducted following the onboard trials, in which Sri. Gayadhar Jena, NGO, SRMSS, Sri. Bikash Das, President, Bahabalapur Trawler

Association, Sri. Gorachand Jena, Vice President, Trawler Association, Sri. Chittaranjan Sahoo, Additional Fishery Officer, Balasore, Sri. Nalinikanta Dash, A.F.O, State Fisheries Department, net shop owners and net menders were attended and discussed the positive results of using square mesh cod end. NETFISH provided T-shirt, cap, gum boot and hand gloves to the



trainees. Certificates were also distributed to the participants.

The Paradeep port trust has sanctioned financial assistance from their CSR fund to NETFISH for carrying out capacity building training programmes for fishers in Odisha and utilizing this fund 13 nos. of awareness training programmes were conducted in Paradeep and Bahabalapur areas during the month. The first programme under the PPT CSR fund was held on 9th Dec. 2019 at Paradeep harbour, where a formal inaugural ceremony was also arranged, in which Mr. Rinkesh Roy, Chairman of Paradeep Port Trust was the Chief Guest.

NETFISH in association with all the stake holder groups took a step to take care of sanitation responsibility of Visakhapattinam fishing harbour by forming a registered Fishing Harbour Management Society. On 7th of the month, SCO NETFISH conducted a

meeting at office of Joint Director of Fisheries with the proposed 11 members of FH management committee. The positions are given to the presidents of all the stakeholder groups within the harbour and FDO as the convener of the Society. SCO NETFISH explained the bylaw of the society. The doubts of the members were also cleared. The committee proposed SCO NETFISH as one among the members of the Management committee and thus inducted him as the Adviser for the society. The Society will be registered immediately after collection of all documents from the members.

Handling practices of fish and ice are improved at Kakinada fishing harbour. Now the big sized fishes are transported by using trolleys. The shrimp and fish are transferred from boat to trader, auction and weighing section by using plastic crates.

NETFISH Kerala South had conducted 3 Skill development training programme, 2 at Thottappally and 1 at Thoppumapdy Fishing harbour on fabrication of 'Square mesh cod ends' on 26th & 27th December 2019. Mr.Salas A.A and Mr.Ajayan, the trained trainers were the resource persons of the programmes. A total of 93 participants actively participated and studied the technique of fabrication of square mesh cod end from diamond mesh net.

NFDB sponsored on-board training programme for Popularization of Square mesh cod ends in trawl net was conducted at Thoppumpady fishing harbour on 16th December 2019. The trainees were first given awareness on importance of use of square mesh cod ends in trawl nets and Minimum Legal size of fishes. A 25 mm diamond shaped Garware net converted into square mesh cod end was used for the onboard trial. A total of 15 beneficiaries attended the training programme.

As part of the popularization of the square mesh cod ends in trawl boats, NETFISH organized a skill development training programme on fabrication of square mesh cod ends to the new net menders at Munambam fishing harbour on 20th December 2019. Sri.Unnikrishnan A.V, trained trainer showed the technique of fabrication of square mesh cod end to the trainees. Later on a group of four trainees was given with a piece of diamond shaped net material and they were asked to convert it into square mesh. All the 23 beneficiaries actively participated and converted the net into square mesh cod end. The trainees were satisfied with the hands on training and they were issued with participation certificate.

NFDB sponsored Onboard programme for popularization of Square mesh cod end in trawl net was conducted at Munambam fishing harbor on 11th December 2019. During the programme, SCO delivered a lecture on importance and advantages of square mesh cod end to the trainees. Dr.Kunal from New Delhi also attended the onboard programme as an observer. Mr.Unnikrishnan. A.V, a trained trainer was the resource person of the training programme and explained the technical aspects of square mesh cod end and showed how the cod end should be connected to the main trawl net. Then the trainer and a trainee together attached the square mesh cod end to the main trawl net. After this, trawl net with square mesh cod end was released to the sea. After one hour hauling, the onboard trail was finished with a good catch of moon fishes, sardine, mackerel, anchovy, crab, squid and ribbon fish. The catch was very clean, free of mud and negligible amount of juvenile fishes. The catch of anchovies was also less. Thus the sorting operation was found simple. The eye appeal of the catch was also impressive. After the onboard trial, the trainees were convinced the advantages of square mesh cod end. The trainees requested to conduct similar programmes in more fishing boats in order to spread the matter quickly. A total of 15 fishermen attended the training programme. NETFISH distributed certificates to all the participants.
