NETFISH – MPEDA, Kolkata had observed '*Swachhta Hi Seva 2019*' through Road Rally by school students, a class on Plastic waste management and collection of wastes and cleaning of Deshapran Fishing Harbour on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Around 35 participants including 22 students of Class XII of Vocational Fisheries of Kishorenagar Sachindra Siksha Sadan, Kishorenagar, Contai, Purba Medinipur, school teachers, Officials from Deshapran Coastal Police Station, public volunteers, Special Officer of Deshapran Fishing Harbour, Harbour Officials, Harbour cleaning staffs, fishermen, net menders, HDCs of Deshapran & Shoula, NGO members etc. attended the programme. Shri.Pranab Kumar Bera, Officer in Charge of Deshapran Coastal Police Station inaugurated the programme and highlighted on the importance of sanitation and cleanliness and also highlighted on role of students for formation of better society. Shri.ArindamSengupta, Special Officer, Deshapran Fishing Harbour explained the significances of hygiene & sanitation condition maintained in the harbour. State Coordinator narrated the importance to observing *Swachhata Hi Seva 2019*. He also took an awareness class on Plastic Waste Management system to the students and also explained the initiative taken by NETFISH in Kerala to eradicate plastic from sea. The SCO also showed a presentation on "An Illustrated guide book for Plastic and Thermocol Ban", Notification by the Dept. of Environment, Govt. of Maharashtra. For the cleanup event NETFISH provided hand gloves, caps and big bags to the participants and all the participants collected plastic bags, PET bottles, plastic cups, thermocol pieces, broken nets & ropes etc. from the premises of Deshapran fishing harbor. Bleaching powder is also applied in the drainages, jetties as well as unhygienic areas for sanitization. All the wastes were collected in the big bags and discarded accordingly. SCO and students urged the net menders and fishers not to through plastic, nets, thermocol, bottles etc. everywhere and to dispose the wastes only at the designated area to make the harbour neat and clean.

About 105 participants including NSS students from Periyar Arts and Science College, Cuddalore and Fisherfolk youths had involved in this Swachhta Hi Seva event. Dr.R. NETFISH distributed 'T" shirts, cotton hand gloves and gunny bags to all the participants and the students actively collected 20 bags / 620kgs of plastic waste, glass pieces, chappals, empty bottles etc. within 2 hours of cleaning work. During the event Ms. K. M. Sarayu, Sub collector of Cuddalore had also joined and greeted the students of Periyar Govt. Arts College, Cuddalore for their involvement in the event.

NETFISH Tamil Nadu South region celebrated the International Coastal Clean-up Day 2019 coupled with the mandate of Swachhata Hi Seva 2019 at Rameswaram Sangumal Beach on 21st September 2019. The program was jointly conducted by The National Centre for Coastal Research (NCCR), Chennai, of Earth Sciences (MoEs), Ministry Government of India, NETFISH, South Asia Co-operative Environment Programme



(SACEP) and M.S. Swaminathan Research Foundation, Poompuhar. Dr. Vinoth Ravindran, SCO NETFISH briefed on the menace of the plastic pollution and its deleterious effect on marine organisms. He also emphasized the role of Swachhta Hi Seva mission of the Government of India towards eradication of plastic pollution. Dr. Velvizhi, Principal Scientist, MSSRF emphasized the importance of International Coastal Cleanup 2019 and role of general public to protect marine and coastal environment from pollution. Dr. Johnson, Senior Scientist, CMFRI, Commander A.K. Dash, Indian Navy and Mr.Vekatachalapathy, Tourist officer also highlighted the importance of clean seas.



150 Around participants including representatives from 5 fishing villages, college students from Alagappa evening college, NGOs, youth volunteers, Naval officers, fisheries officials, MSSRF staff and consumer organizations took part in the event. The participants of the event holding placards bearing slogans such as "Don't litter it makes the world better" "Clean beach! A paradise on earth" "Save our coast, Conserve the future"

"Vulnerable Coast! Seek attention" etc. enchanted slogans emphasizing the importance of coastal cleanliness and avoiding plastic pollution. An oath "**Say No to plastic for a better and Green tomorrow**" was also pronounced. The participants were divided into 10 groups and they collected debris from entire Sangumal beach for a distance of about 1 km. The collected debris was segregated with the support of volunteers and Municipality of Rameswaram and the composition was documented. The total debris amounted to about 1.3 tons comprised of plastic bags, bottles and cups (300kgs), glass bottles (702kg), cloths (14kg) ropes (80 kgs), boat discards such as thermocol and nets

(66kgs), chappels (30kg) and others (30 kg). Certificates were issued to encourage the volunteers. The segregated debris was handed over to the Municipality of Rameshwaram for proper disposal.

He explained that the harmful effects of plastic on aquatic life are devastating, and accelerating. Shri. Vasanth Kumar, Professor, Govt. Science College, Karwar, inaugurated the programme and highlighted about the harmful effect of plastic to human and environment. Shri.ThokuHarikantra, Director, Fishermen Co-operative Society, Mudga, advised the fishers to properly utilize the facilities provided to them in the harbour. Shri. Sandesh Ullakashi, Head Master, JanataVidyalaya, Amdalli after the presidential address administered the oath "*not to use of plastic straws for drinking cold drinks*". Smt. NidhiNaik, Field Co-ordinator, SCODWES gave vote of thanks. After the

stage function a rally was organized in which more than 100 students and public participated saying slogans against the use of plastic. A demonstration on proper cleaning of fishing harbour and auction hall was also done by Shri. Umesh Marati and State Coordinator. After that all the participants cleaned the auction hall and wharf areas.



Due to intervention, nearly 40% of the fishing vessel owners started giving log sheets during August 2019 and during September the percentage of log sheet collection has increased to 52%.

As a result of NETFISH regular awareness programmes the fishers at Malim in Goa and Amdalli in Karnataka has started unloading fish directly to crates instead of dumping fish on floor.
