- NETFISH along with CIFNET Kochi had organized 3 awareness programmes for the fishers at Chellanam, Thottappally & Cherai regions
- State Coordinator, West Bengal along with Deputy Director, MPEDA, RD, Kolkata had visited Tripura and made a series of meetings with the CEO and officials of Tripura Tribal Autonomous District Council (TTAADC), officials of State fisheries and Secretary of fisheries, Govt. of Tripura and other stakeholders regarding setting up of mechanical solar dryer under the NETFISH MPEDA financial assistance scheme, development of GIFT hatchery & grow out and development of dry fish sector.
- ➢ 53 nos. of awareness classes on Hygiene & Conservation and Covid-19 guidelines were organized through the Harbour Data Collectors at respective harbours.
- Conducted physical verification and review meeting of HDCs at various fishing harbours and landing centres.
- Disseminated information among stakeholders on protection of Marine mammals and sea turtles, Eradication of single use plastic, Hygienic handling of fish, personal hygiene, etc. through Whatsapp group formed in fishing harbours.

The dry fishers of Visakhapatnam fishing harbour are now selling their product in improved way using newly constructed facility with the funds of Visakhapatnam Port Trust. Usually, the dry fish traders selling their product on roadside by using a small sheet or piece of net. Due to the awareness generated by NETFISH, now the Dry fishers are doing trade in an improved way. Now some of them show interest in selling the dry fish products in packaged form.

- As a result of NETFISH awareness programme on conservation of Juvenile fishes, the boats operating with ring seine nets are now observed doing fishing only beyond 8 km from the coast. If there is any violation by the ring seine fishers, the traditional fishermen are objecting and not allowing them to do fishing. Dept. of Fisheries is also observing and taking control measures by doing patrolling with the support of Marine Police. With this control the traditional fishermen are noticed that the fishing is satisfactory as juveniles are saved and growing.
- The awareness generated by the HDC on Marine Mammal Protection Act during the MMPA survey at Pudimadaka fish landing center, Visakhapatnam the fishermen of Tantadi village are

informed to the Dept. of Forest and saved the live Whale Shark of 2 tons weight came to the coast which was unable to go back to the sea. As the shark was unable to go back to the waters the local fishermen helped in releasing it back to sea alive.

NETFISH Tamil Nadu South region in association with Perkin Elmer had arranged 2 nos. of onsite Histamine testing demonstration programme at Taruvaikulam and Thengapattinam FH on 16<sup>th</sup>& 17<sup>th</sup> of the month respectively. Dr.Joice V.Thomas, CE NETFISH delivered the inaugural address and emphasized the importance of knowledge on histamine to fishermen. Mr. S. Asok Kumar, DD, MPEDA, SRD, Tuticorin explained about Scombrotoxin as a food borne toxin associated with the consumption of fish particularly species belonging to Scombridae and Scomberesocidae families such as tuna and mackerel. He also indicated how histamine content can be a deterrent to exports of fishes such as Tuna and Mackerel. Mr. Vijayaragavan, ADF (Marine), Dept of Fisheries and

Fishermen welfare, Tuticorin congratulated the efforts of NETFISH-MPEDA for taking the initiative for the betterment of quality of fishes landed in Tharuvaikulam. He also highlighted the participatory approach of NETFISH with Dept of Fisheries and Fishermen welfare in such field level activities. Mr. Amarjeet Sharma, Business Development Officer, Perkin Elmer, Mumbai detailed the HISTASTRIP product description.

Later on, Dr. Vinoth S Ravindran, State Coordinator NETFISH, extracted the muscle from various locations viz., pectoral, dorsal and caudal fin regions in sterile condition aseptically and in a manner such as to avoid cross contamination of samples and handed over for further histamine determination. Ms. Swapna, Technologist, Perkin Elmer, USA performed the Rapid visual colorimetric strip test for the determination of Histamine in fresh fish. The results based on colour change were explained to the officials and Fisher folk. The deep sea fishermen were very much happy to see the quality of their fishes for the first time and promised that they could further improve the quality of the fishes.

#### Impacts/Outcomes observed during the month

1. It is observed that due to continuous awareness meeting by HDCs & SCO, Fishermen of Jafrabad, Veraval, Mangrol, Porbandar and Vanakbara are bringing back all plastic /solid wastes comes during fishing to land for proper disposal.



2. Before training there was no insulated box in fishing vessels, but due to NETFISH MPEDA awareness programmes, the Vessel owner purchased insulated box and given to the workers for quick chilling of fishes to reduce post harvest loss.



3. Due to NETFISH awareness programme, Fishermen of Veraval, Mangrol and Porbandar started to use plastic sheets and stopped putting fish on dirty floor.

Due to NETFISH MPEDA's continuous trainings, awareness meetings and Mass communication with stakeholders, the active group of fishermen along with cooperative society and fishermen community of Mangrol prepared around 700 artificial fish aggregation devices and started to deploy in to the sea. *This is the most important out come during the year of 2021-22 as far as concern to conservation of Marine ecosystem*
