- Disseminated information among stakeholders on protection of Marine mammals and sea turtles, Eradication of single use plastic, Hygienic handling of fish, personal hygiene, etc. through Whatsapp group formed in fishing harbours.

On 15th February 2022, NETFISH Kolkata had organized a special programme for distribution of fishermen aid material to the SC Boat owners under MPEDA SC/ST project fund. Shri. Archimin Lahiri, Deputy Director, MPEDA, Dr. N.A. Talwar, Prof. & HOD of Dept. of Fisheries Engineering & Technology, West Bengal University of Animal & Fishery Science, Chakgaria, Kolkata (Expert Committee Member), Representatives of M/s. Nilkamal Ltd., Shri. Atanu Ray, State Coordinator, NETFISH, HDCs and boat owners were attended the programme. State Coordinator welcomed the participants and highlighted the significance of insulated fish box (IFB) distribution programme and chill killing practices. Deputy Director explained about the fish quality, fish spoilage and uses of IFB, post harvest loss of captured fishes, capacity building programmes among the fishers and adequate infrastructure facilities needed at the fishing vessel and fish landing centres. He also urged the fishers to practice chill killing method to retain the best quality fish. During the function 9 boat owners from Kakdwip fishermen association were provided with 40 nos. of Insulated fish box consist of 70 lit and 310 lit capacities. NETFISH has given 75% of the cost of IFB and 25% has been contributed by SC/ST beneficiaries.

Due to the impact of NETFISH awareness programme on fish quality management, it is noticed that the Yellow fin tuna of about 15 Kg are landing with GG grade at Pudimadaka fish landing centre. The boat crews are doing this process onboard itself. They also practicing pre cooling and empty guts & gills were filled with ice before storage in fish hold.

Innovative/Sustainable fishing practice observed during the month

Dr. Girija Behere, State Co-ordinator, NETFISH-MPEDA, MH North region had visited the house of Mr. Vinayak Damodar Sakharkar at Alibaug Koliwada, Raigad and interviewed his efforts towards eradication of plastic and bringing back plastic from the sea to land. He is bringing back plastic caught in gill net with his small boat going for single day fishing. With the help of 2 more crew members, he is engaged in this activity for past 20 years and brings nearly 25 kg or more quantity of plastic everyday at least for 240 days in a year and putting all the collected plastic into the dustbin kept by Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation. On behalf of NETFISH and MPEDA, SCO appreciated his efforts towards saving ocean. He is also releasing matured lobster females caught in the net to the sea and engaged in conservation of fishery resources in the sea.
