Activities of NETFISH in December 2010

The extension activities of NETFISH during December 2010 included 261 regular training programmes, 56 special programmes, 2 boat registration campaigns and a series of meetings & discussions. NETFISH conducted 26 regular extension training programmes, 12 street plays and 2 boat registration campaigns in West Bengal during December 2010. The street plays were performed at Contai, Ramnagar, Freserganj and Kakdwip regions. One day mike campaign on Registration and Licensing of fishing boats, including pasting & circulating leaflets, was conducted at Shoula, Sankarpur fishing harbor, digha mohana etc. of Purba Medinipur district. One spot registration camp was also organized at Digha mohana. A series of meetings were conducted with State Fisheries Officials & fishermen associations regarding Boat Registration. On 22nd December'10 a meeting was held with Asst. Director of Fisheries (Marine), Diamond Harbour, Dist. Fisheries Officer (Marine) and FEO regarding licensing and registration of fishing boat, registration of aqua farms and related problems. They ensured their co-operation in arranging camps for registering & licensing of boats.

Along the coastal districts of Andhra Pradesh 23 regular extension programmes were conducted during the month through the NGO members or directly by the SCo. The SCo coordinated with AD, MPEDA, RO, Vizag for final inspection of 8 newly constructed fish holds of Nizampatnam fishing harbour. On 28.12.10 a meeting was held with the Hussur and Sons company, Machelipatnam who are having 12 mechanized fishing vessels, to make them avoid the use of bamboo baskets in their fishing vessels. As a result they are ready to buy 100 plastic baskets. A discussion was held with the Port officers of State Ports Department, Machelipatnam regarding the basic structures required for the installation of Tube ice machine. Money for this is sanctioned and the State Port Authority has to call for tenders. SCo is following to make ready of basic structure by the end of January, 2011. Fish drying activities are

found intensified at Machelipatnam fishing harbour. The traders were explained the need to avoid drying on wharf area and also informed the Port officers to not to allow them to do fish drying activities in the harbour premises.

NETFISH conducted 31 nos. of extension training programmes in the month of December, 2010 along Chennai Region. A meeting was held with the President of Meenavar Ikkiya Sabai at Kasimedu Fishing Harbour regarding the improvement of handling of Ice and Fish. Meenavar Ikkiya Sabai also strictly banned the toilet on the beach and monitoring the same. Also we have propagated the use of Plastic baskets against bamboo baskets. A meeting was arranged with Boat Owners Association in Pazhaiyar regarding the formation of the Society. At Cuddalore FH, the severe impact of Purse Seine operation is noticed and it is planning to focus on creating awareness on impact of Purse seine operation among Boat owners in future programmes.

In Tuticorin Region all the boats are registered thereby successfully completing the boat registration campaign.

Along Northern Kerala, 20 regular programmes, 1 mass communication programme and 15 street play shows were conducted at the selected regions during the month. The harbours were also monitored and proper actions were taken to improve the conditions at the harbour. All arrangements for the registration of boats were also done at the selected harbours.

In the selected areas of southern Kerala, 18 regular programmes and one mass communication programme were conducted. Regular campaigns on boat registration were also arranged through field officers at Shakthikulangara and Thoppumpady harbours. A meeting was held with boat owners at Neendakara to discuss on society formation, registration of fishing boats and fish quality management through hygienic practices. The fisheries inspector at Vypeen was met to discuss regarding boat registration and fishing license. At Thoppumpady a meeting was arranged with the purse seine boat owners to discuss on drawbacks of Chinese engine. Spot registration camps were arranged at Thoppumpady and Kollam regions. Hygienic condition and over all cleaning at Thoppumpady and Sakthikulangara harbours were found well improved.
