As per the instructions from HO, a special field visit to CPC at Balaramgadi was done to prepare a detailed report on the existing conditions there. As part of the exposure visit programme, on 20th February, a team of 7 members from Paradeep Fishing harbour visited Bahabalpur landing centre to interact with Bahabalapur trawler association members regarding fish quality. The visit was organized by NETFISH involving the trawler association members of Paradeep fishing harbour, NGO member, Bahabalpur trawler association members, State Fishery, E.I.A, MPEDA, etc. The main objective of the meeting was to upgrade the fish quality at Paradeep fishing harbour. A four day awareness camp was also organized at Bhubaneswar from 14th to 17th Feb. 2011.

15 street play shows were also performed in three days at Aqua-Aquaria 2011, Chennai. The plastic basket exclusively designed for use in fishing boats and harbours was launched on 22.02.2011 in view of avoiding the use of bamboo baskets. Boat owners are very happy and showed their willingness in using this kind of baskets rather than the available round plastic baskets. On 16.03.2011 a discussion was held with the Port Conservator and Traffic Inspector of Visakhapatnam Port Trust regarding the repair of pressure washer for harbour cleaning activities. On 23.02.2011 a meeting was arranged with DD & AD of State Fisheries Department to discuss the regular cleaning activities of Kakinada fishing harbour. The matter was discussed with harbour management committee and the committee took initiation to increase the intensity of cleaning and formed a regular cleaning schedule.

15 street play shows were performed by the street play team of Kollam region. A discussion was held with Boat owners Association of Kollam region regarding sustainable fisheries and bad impact of bottom trawling. As a result of continuous training programme, the Boat owners Association of Kollam region have decided to stop night trawling and inshore trawling. The so called "valam fishing" is also controlled in this area. After our continuous

discussion with Harbour Engineering Division of Sakthikulangara, two persons are appointed for removing fishing waste from area and it is used for biogas treatment. A discussion was held with peeling shed owners of Aroor region regarding their problems.

Along Northern region of Kerala, 15 street play shows were also conducted during the month. Matsyafed also associated with NETFISH in conducting some of the training programmes.
