MPEDA NETFISH, with financial support from Paradeep Port Authority under CSR funding, successfully organized a series of Seafood Value Addition Skill Development Training Programmes across major coastal regions of Odisha during April 2026. The programme was conducted with the objective of enhancing the technical skills and livelihood opportunities of fishers, women Self Help Groups, and coastal youth through training in seafood value addition and hygienic fish processing practices. The initiative aimed to promote income diversification, encourage small-scale seafood entrepreneurship, improve post-harvest fish handling practices, and create awareness on quality standards and market-oriented seafood products. The programmes were conducted by a team of experienced trainers and technical experts including Shri. S. K. Mohapatra, SCO Odisha, Shri. Atanu Ray, SCO West Bengal, Fisheries officials and HDCs.

The training sessions consisted of both theoretical classes and practical demonstrations focusing on hygienic handling of fish and shrimp, seafood processing techniques, packaging and preservation methods, quality control measures, food safety practices, and marketing strategies for local as well as export-oriented seafood products. Special emphasis was given to value addition technologies that can be adopted at small-scale and household levels for generating additional income among fishing communities. Participants received hands-on training in the preparation of several value-added seafood products such as Nobashi Shrimp, Butterfly Shrimp, Fish Fingers, Fish Cutlets, Fish Balls, Fish Pickle, Prawn Pickle, and other innovative seafood products with market potential.

The programme witnessed enthusiastic participation from fishers, women SHGs, and coastal youth from various fishing villages of Odisha. The practical-oriented training helped participants improve their technical knowledge and develop entrepreneurial skills related to seafood value addition and hygienic processing. The programme also enhanced awareness regarding fish quality maintenance, safe food handling practices, product diversification, and value chain development. Through this initiative, participants gained exposure to improved

processing techniques and business opportunities that can support self-employment and small-scale seafood enterprises in coastal areas.
