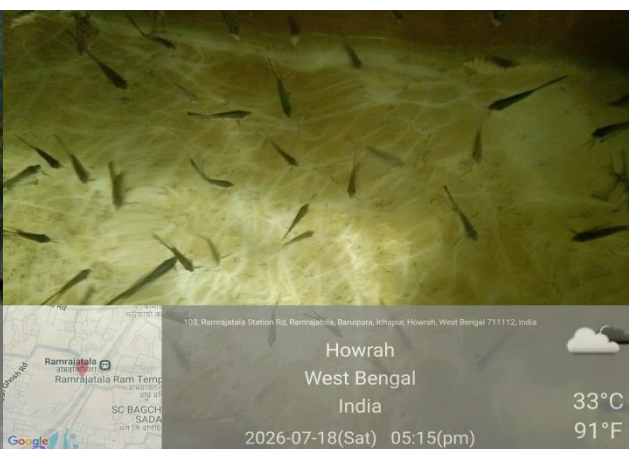

The programme brought together Fisheries Department officials, ICAR-CIFT experts, MPEDA-NETFISH representatives, trawler owners, fishermen, and other stakeholders. Experts highlighted the ecological, economic, and legal benefits of TED and provided technical guidance on its installation, operation, and maintenance. The interactive session addressed fishermen's queries and encouraged voluntary adoption of TED and responsible fishing practices. The programme concluded with a renewed commitment among stakeholders to promote sustainable marine fisheries and protect endangered sea turtles in Odisha.

Fishing Harbour Based Program at Machilipattinam

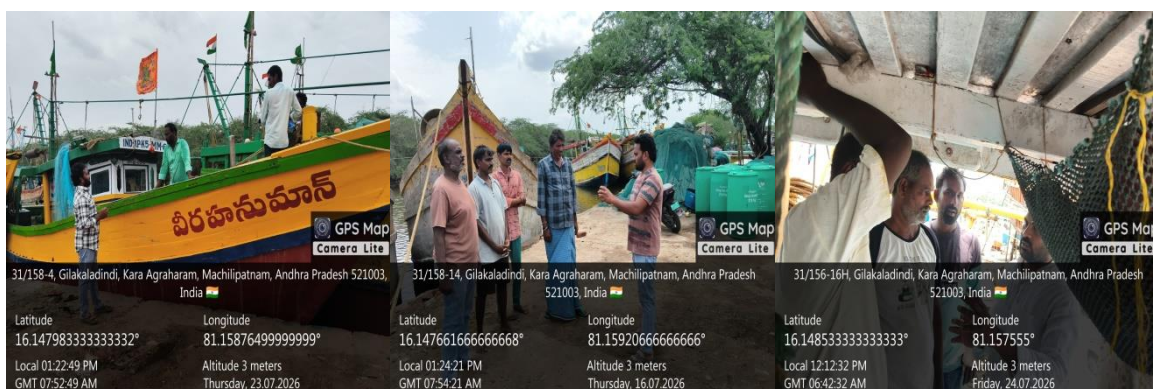

A One-Day Training Programme on Inspection of TED was organized by MPEDA-NETFISH for officials of the Department of Fisheries, Kerala, on 23 July 2026 at the Awareness Centre, Fisheries Complex, Ernakulam, with the objective of strengthening the capacity of field-level fisheries officials in the inspection, monitoring and implementation of TEDs in accordance with the standards stipulated by the US NOAA. The program also aimed to develop a pool of trained master trainers within the Department of Fisheries to facilitate effective TED implementation across the coastal districts of Kerala. The program commenced with registration and an inaugural session, followed by technical presentations covering the construction, field demonstration and implementation of TEDs in India, as well as their importance, design, regulatory provisions and compliance requirements. The sessions were delivered by experts from MPEDA-NETFISH and ICAR-CIFT, followed by interactive discussions and a demonstration video on TED installation and operation. Participants were subsequently provided with detailed guidance on the procedures and methods for inspection of TEDs, followed by hands-on practical training on TED measurement and inspection conducted by the technical team of MPEDA-NETFISH and ICAR-CIFT. The program concluded with a question-and-answer session and collection of feedback from the participants. The participants expressed their appreciation to MPEDA-NETFISH for organizing the program in a systematic and time-bound manner and particularly highlighted the effectiveness of the theory sessions, technical presentations, demonstration videos and hands-on practical training in improving their understanding and skills in TED inspection and measurement.
