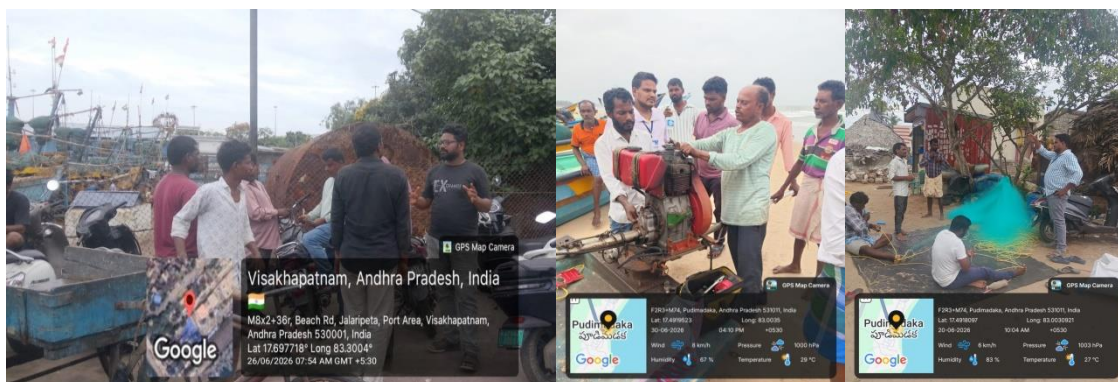

MPEDA-NETFISH successfully organized two numbers of three-day Exposure Visit and Capacity Building Programmes for 60 fisherwomen from Karaikal and Puducherry during June 2026, with financial support from the Department of Fisheries, Puducherry. The programmes combined exposure visits to internationally approved seafood processing units with hands-on training in seafood value addition, hygienic fish handling, packaging, entrepreneurship, and square mesh fabrication by CIFNET experts. Participants gained practical knowledge of modern seafood processing, export standards, responsible fishing practices, and sustainable fisheries management. The initiative strengthened the technical skills and entrepreneurial capacity of the fisherwomen, promoting self-employment, improved livelihoods, and greater participation of women in fisheries-based enterprises.

Four numbers of four-day capacity-building training program on Sustainable Product Development using Water Hyacinth was conducted during the month by MPEDA-NETFISH and Future Kerala Mission-JAIN (Deemed-to-be University) for 80 Scheduled Caste fishers from Valanthakkadu, Ernakulam and Chemmanakari, Kottayam districts. The program aimed to transform water hyacinth into commercially viable products while promoting ecological restoration and sustainable livelihoods in fishing communities. Participants were trained in the production of hand-made paper, pulp-based handicrafts, woven baskets, and utility products, along with sessions on digital marketing, entrepreneurship, and institutional support mechanisms. The training successfully enhanced the skills and confidence of the participants, who displayed high-quality products during the valedictory session and expressed interest in forming FPOs and expanding enterprise opportunities. The initiative forms part of a three-phase project focused on skill development, master trainer creation, and exposure visits to strengthen sustainable livelihood opportunities for SC fishers.
