The continuous awareness programmes conducted by NETFISH among the dry fishers of Visakhapatnam fishing harbour resulted in 90% change in fish drying practices. Now the fishers started using tarpaulin sheets for fish drying instead of bare lands and cement platforms.

Impacts/Outcomes observed during the month

- The continuous awareness programme among the SC/ST Black clam fishers at Vaikom area has resulted in improving the hygienic handling of the product. Earlier they used to wash the black clam in the dirty water from the lake. But now they use clean water and also ensure proper and hygienic cleaning of the product.
- After attending the value addition training programme, one lady has started a petty shop selling bajis, samosas, tapioca balls etc., and earning good income. Some of the ladies attended the trainings have started providing products to the '*Thozhilurappu* workers' of their area and earning money.
- As a result of series of meetings and discussions made at Neendakara Fishing harbour, several actions have been initiated to maintain the hygienic condition of the harbour. A new modern pressurized cleaning vehicle have been procured for cleaning the auction hall. Majoriy of empty boxes kept inside the auction hall were removed. Evicted the ladies fish vendors, who have been occupied the auction hall for selling fishes for the last so many years in the auction hall. To prevent bird entry in to the auction hall, bird proofing nets were provided. The cleaning workers in the

harbour were provided with gumboot, lotion, bleaching powder and gloves for cleaning. The bushes around the harbour area were removed and necessary measures have been taken to cut down the bushes in future, using the service of '*Thozhilurappu* workers'.

As an impact of NETFISH awareness programmes, the Mahavir Fisheries Cooperative society of Mangrol had released more than 300 FAD (artificial reef) in to Sea, as a conservation method to regenerate fish habitat.



As a result of harbour based training programmes conducted at Veraval/Mangrol & Porbandar fishermen are following good handling and conservation practices like adopting quick chilling method to reduce post-harvest loss, using clean sea water for cleaning their vessel, bringing plastic waste to land for safe disposal, releasing turtles in live condition back to sea, etc.
