Highlights of the Month

- Conducted **a two-days hands-on training on seafood value-added products** at Diu, to enhance livelihood opportunities for SHGs, fishers, and entrepreneurs in the UT.
- Conducted **6 nos. of Capacity building training program for SC Fishers** in various regions. In addition State Coordinator Andhra North region had coordinated with RD MPEDA for conducting 1 no. of awareness program for SC/ST fishermen.
- Conducted **3 nos. of Sea food unit training programs** in West Bengal & Tamil Nadu South and an income of Rs.30,000/- is generated for NETFISH as training fee.
- Conducted **21 nos. of awareness programs, 4 nos. of onboard fishing trials, and 11 nos. of Boat to Boat campaigns** in various regions for the **adoption of TEDs** by the fishers.
- Conducted **10 nos. of Paradeep Port Trust funded awareness programs** in various regions of Odisha.
- Conducted **4 nos. of MFHMS funded awareness programs** in Munambam.
- NETFISH had coordinated with CIFNET for conducting a **3 day skill development training program** on Life saving and electronic equipment's and a **one day awareness program** on Sea safety, Navigation, Boat engine repairing and Electronics in Karnataka.
- **272 nos. of awareness classes** on Hygiene & Conservation were organized through the **Harbour Data Collectors** at respective harbours.
- NETFISH SCOs have coordinated and act as trainers for conducting **2 Value Addition Training Programs** by MPEDA field offices.
